BY DEFINITION

Conditional Text:

(noun) Content within a document that is meant to appear in some renditions of the document but not other renditions.

Grep: (Global/Regular Expression/Print)

A flexible search-and-replace function that can search one or more files for specified characters and/or strings. It also allows non-specific searches for partial strings.

Cross Reference:

(noun) An instance within a document which refers to related or synonymous information elsewhere, usually within the same work.
