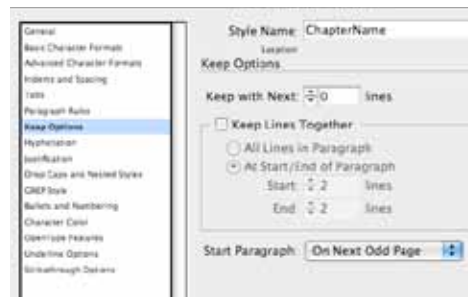

## BY DEFINITION

### Conditional Text:

*(noun) Content within a document that is meant to appear in some renditions of the document but not other renditions.*

**Grep:** *(Global/Regular Expression/Print)*

*A flexible search-and-replace function that can search one or more files for specified characters and/or strings. It also allows non-specific searches for partial strings.*

### Cross Reference:

*(noun) An instance within a document which refers to related or synonymous information elsewhere, usually within the same work.*
